






## Number of drug users and prevalence rates (among population age 15-64)

## Significant individual drug seizure cases in Western Indian Ocean, 2017-2023








## The Taliban's ban on narcotic drugs, 2022

On 3 April 2022, the Taliban issued a decree on the "Prohibition of Poppy Cultivation and all types of Narcotics". The decree still included a two-months grace per 2022 opium season; the opium ban thus – de-facto – only started with the winter season 2022.

Area under opium poppy cultivation and opium production fell by 95 per cent in 2023










## Annual methamphetamine seizures reported from Western Indian Ocean countries, 2012-2022

## New Psychoactive Substances identified at the global level




Psychotropic substances (1971 Convention) Narcotic drugs (1961 Convention) NPS identified for the first time in current year NPS identified in previous years Total number of substances
